Frequently Asked Questions

Can you give me the basics of when, where, etc?

Saturday, April 14, at the Richardson Public Library. Doors open at 7:00pm, the play begins at 7:30pm.

Who is in the play?

The Murder Mystery Players, a professional theater company, will present and produce the play, which also features some of Richardson’s finest community leaders: Jeannie Stone – RISD superintendent; Marta Gomez Frey – City of Richardson city council; Kirk Wilson – Dean Heating & Air Conditioning owner; and Edward Renteria – Blue Cross Blue Shield senior manager.

How much are the tickets?

Tickets are \$60 each and include hors d’oeuvres, desserts and drinks. They can be purchased from the Richardson Adult Literacy Center (www.ralc.org/murder-mystery or 972-644-5119) starting February 1.
